The graphic charter is a working document that contains the basic rules for the use of the graphic signs that make up Fairville's graphic identity.

Chapter 01 The logotype

The logotype is the emblem of the project.

By combining a specific shape, colours and graphics, it is the unifying element of the Fairville identity.





This is the project symbol. It is to be used on all the supports of the project.

The logotype exists in a complete version. It consists of the combination of the symbol and the typography.

Monochrome versions of the logotype are to be used when technical and charter constraints do not allow the logotype to be used in colour (e.g. stamps, FAX, regional daily press, fabrics, certain goodies, etc.).

The logo is applied in the same way on all light coloured backgrounds.

Be careful to ensure the contrast between the background and the logo.

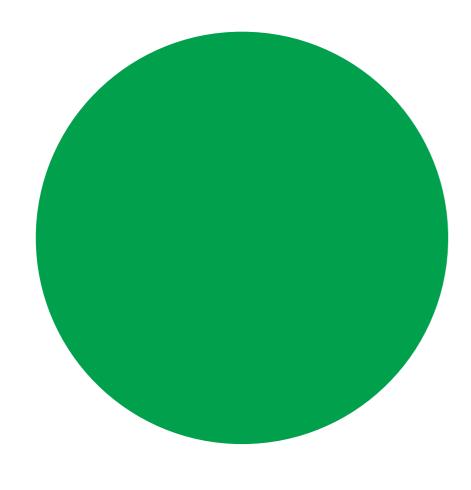
On dark backgrounds I recommend using the grey or white monochrome version.

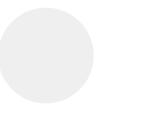

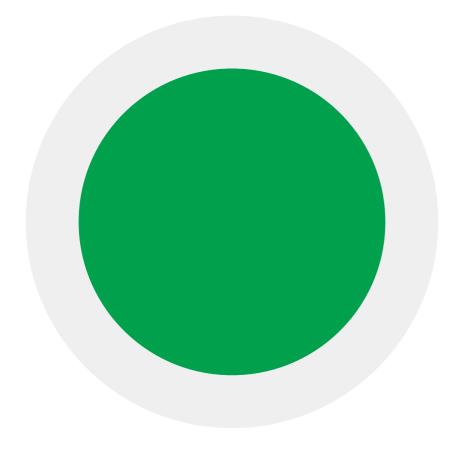

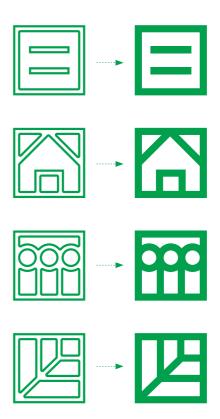
Karelia will be used mainly for titles, exergues and subtitles.

Chapter 04 The iconographic territory







The geometric style is an integral part of the territory. The 4 icons define the pictogram style of the identity. They can be used as independent graphic elements.

It is possible to play on the switch between the full and the wired.

Primarily, the identity works on the outline.



The layout is simple and uncluttered, with a simplified grid to highlight the important elements, as well as the different reading levels. The four icons of the logo are arranged vertically and form the main graphic element of the poster.









The editions can be produced on matt or craft paper for a raw and natural effect in the spirit of recycling.
